

Minutes of Meeting – Lockdown Day 8 (18/08/2020)

Agenda and decisions

Quarantine requirement for people having travel history from Phuentsholing from August 10, 2020

- The chief of quarantine Logistics, Mr. Pema Dorji, Chief DEO, Contact no. 17122409, will be the first point of contact for actions related to people with travel history to Phuentsholing.
- The quarantine team will follow the standard protocols related to quarantine issued by the Ministry of Health.
- All people put in facility quarantine as of now will continue to stay quarantine till completion of two weeks period as per directives from Ministry of Health.
- The decisions taken in the previous meetings related to quarantine shall remain nullified based on advice from technical experts.

Rapid test requirement

- With increased risk from huge unregulated number of people who entered the dzongkhag from Phuentsholing, the Dzongkhag health team has started Rapid Test by three teams (From Pinsa- South, Khotokha- East, Phobji-Gangtey - North) from August 18, 2020.

Ration for Desuups involved in delivery of essentials good and stationed at old hospital

- Considering the risks associated with responsibilities assigned to Desuups involved in essential goods supply, accommodation will be provided at Bajo HSS and ration adjusted from the lump sum allowance of Nu. 500/- per head.

Report on opening of shops without permission

- Shops identified by the Food and essential supply team will be provided with identity stickers for easy monitoring by the patrolling personnel and to prevent opening of other unauthorized shops. Food and Essential Goods Supply team to issue stickers on a daily basis.

Permit to allow waste collection on daily basis

- Daily collection of wastes within and vicinity of Bajo town will be allowed. However, other requirement will remain as per the previous decision.

Overdraft Facility for Government Vehicles deployed for COVID-19 duty

- All identified government vehicles deployed for COVID-19 response shall be allowed avail fuel on overdraft (OD) facility from specified petroleum distributors.
- Mr. Tenzin Phuntsho, MTO will prepare list of vehicles to avail OD facility and share with the petroleum distributors.
