Based on the test report of “Mass Sweeping” carried out for the residents in red zones/areas on 10<sup>th</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup> March 2022 in Wangdue Phodrang Dzongkhag, the Dzongkhag COVID-19 Task Force (DC19TF) is pleased to notify the following changes on the color coding and further relaxations with effect from 13<sup>th</sup> March 2022.

**1. Transition from **Red Zones** to **Green Zones**:**

During the mass sweeping of the residents in Dabcheykha Matshigkha, all the samples tested NEGATIVE. Furthermore, there is no primary contact in the community. Therefore, the **Dabcheykha Matshigkha Chiwog** under Gase Tshogongm Gewog shall be transitioned from Red to Green zone.
