1. Transition from **Red Zones to **Green Zones**:**

During the mass sweeping of the residents in Rabuna, Lawakha and areas between Gangthangka and Tikizampa, all the samples tested NEGATIVE. Furthermore, there is no primary contacts in the community. Therefore, the following areas shall be transitioned from Red to Green zones.

Religious activities at home must be limited to family members with not more than 5 religious' personnel. f. Construction activities with sufficient materials at site may resume. g. Emergency/Essential outbound travel (Negative RT-PCR test result). h. Offices (Within the same zone). i. All essential services (Medical, electricity, telecom, waste, Cable TV etc). j. Public transport like buses and Taxi can operate at 50% capacity within same Chiwog. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Sports and Games including archery and Khuru. b. Vehicle movements (Except those approved for special cases). c. Visiting neighbors and Social Gathering. d. Inter-zone movements e. Bar/Karaokes/night clubs/discotheques. f. For the Residents in Red Buildings and Red Flats in the Yellow Zones:

- i. The residents must follow the red building and red flat protocol.
- ii. The essential items and services shall be delivered by respective essential delivery team in the areas/zones

General DOs

- Mandatory use of Druk Trace App at shops and other public places.
