**Public Notification**

In continuation to our earlier public notification No. Wangdue/Covid-19/2021/2022/156 dated April 04, 2022 and in accordance with the Press Release from the Office of the Prime Minister on April 23, 2022, the DC19TF, Wangdue Phodrang is pleased to notify the following additional information with effect from May 2, 2022;

1. All in-person meetings/conferences/seminars/training will be allowed. However, virtual meetings/conferences/seminars/training are strongly encouraged to bring about greater efficiency and resource optimization.
2. All entertainment centers will resume regular business with 50 percent occupancy and remain open till 11pm.
3. The closing time for all other business will also extend from 9pm to 11pm.
4. All indoor and outdoor sporting will be permitted with spectator. But individuals showing signs and symptoms of COVID-19 are discouraged from taking part in any sporting activities.
5. All mass gathering, including religious and cultural congregations will be allowed to a maximum of 100 people, with observance of basic COVID-19 protocols such as face masks and hand washing. Above the allowable number, organisers must seek clearance from DC19TF.

Meanwhile, we request everyone to take utmost care and continue to use face masks and practice frequent hand washing. This will not only help avoid COVID-19 but also other communicable respiratory disease.
