Public Notification

In accordance with the Press Release from the Office of the Prime Minister on May 08, 2022, the Dzongkhag COVID-19 Task Force, Wangdue Phodrang is pleased to notify the following additional relaxations with effect from May 9, 2022;

1. All entertainment centers can now resume their regular business at full capacity.
2. All mass gathering, including religious ceremonies such as *Tshechus* and *Moenlam Chenmos* will be allowed with strict observance of basic COVID-19 protocols such as face masks and hand washing.
3. All indoor and outdoor sporting activities including tournaments will be permitted with spectator. However, individuals showing signs and symptoms of COVID-19 are discouraged from taking part in any sporting activities.
4. Virtual meetings/conferences/seminars/training are strongly encouraged to bring about greater efficiency and resource-saving. In cases where it is absolutely necessary to have in-person meetings, the meetings should be held in a well-ventilated room and coordinators must ensure that all participants use facemasks and practice hand washing/sanitizing.

Meanwhile, we request everyone to take utmost care and continue to use face masks and practice frequent hand washing. This will not only help avoid COVID-19 but also other communicable respiratory disease.
